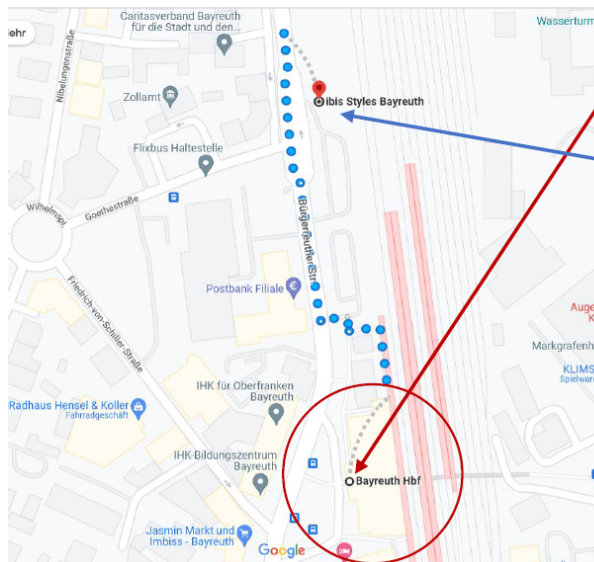


Bayreuth Transportation Guide

How to get to your Accommodation:

Ibis Styles & Ibis Budget: Bürgerreuther Strasse 6, 95444 Bayreuth



You leave the **main station** here

And this is where you find the **hotel**

Hotel Bayrischer Hof: Bahnhofsstraße 15, 95444 Bayreuth

Located right on the left when leaving the main station.

How to get to the University:

The most comfortable way to get to campus is to take the **bus 316** direction “Geowissenschaften” leaving from the main station (“Hauptbahnhof”) and exit at “Mensa” or “Uni-Verwaltung” (10 min).

The other option is to take a bus from the Central Bus station (“ZOH”). You can walk there (9 min) or take a bus from the main station to the ZOH. From there you can take bus 306 or 304 to the University.

Buses connecting main station and ZOH:

302 to St. Johannis: Leaves outside the main station (stop 9) at **.03 and .33** every hour (from 8-18 o'clock).

305 to Mayernberg/Nord: Leaves outside main station on the opposite side of the road (use zebra crossing) at .03, .33 (8-11 o'clock), .03, .10, .23, .53, .55 (12 o'clock) and .03, .23, .43 (13-18 o'clock)

309 to Meyernberg/Süd: Same bus stop as 305, leaves at **.50** (8-11 o'clock), **.52** (12 o'clock), **.50** (13-18 o'clock).

Buses connecting ZOH and the University:

306 to Campus: Leaves at ZOH stop L (opposite NORMA-supermarket) at .00, .20, .40 every hour (8-18 o'clock)

304 to Birken/Universität: Also leaves at ZOH stop L –at .10, .30, .50 (8-18 o'clock)

On the way back, you can take either bus 316 direction “*Hauptbahnhof*” or the option via the Central Bus station for any bus direction “*ZOH*”.

How to get to Bayreuth:

By train:

As Bayreuth does not have a long-distance train station, the best way to reach the town is via *Bamberg* or *Nuremberg* (Nürnberg). From there you can take a local train connecting to *Bayreuth* (Bayreuth Hauptbahnhof). Sometimes, only one part of the train actually goes to Bayreuth and the other one is decoupled. So make sure that you entered the correct train with “Bayreuth” as destination.

By plane:

If you plan to come to Bayreuth by plane the nearest regional airport is in *Nuremberg* (Nürnberg). From there you have to take a train to the main station (Nuremberg airport to Nuremberg main station) and then take a 1-hour-train to *Bayreuth* (Bayreuth Hauptbahnhof).

The better-connected airport in *Munich* might also be a good option. From there, you can reach Bayreuth within 3h 30min by train via Nuremberg. See detailed information about the train above.

By car:

The university is located right next to the Autobahn A9 exit Bayreuth south, so it is very easy to reach. There are plenty of parking spots at the university free of charge.
